In line with the recent COVID-19 outbreak, Olympia Orthopaedic Associates is taking proactive measures to prevent exposure in our facilities.

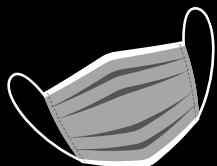
You are required to notify us **prior to entering our clinic if:**

- You have developed any of the following symptoms within the last day, that are not caused by another condition: fever (100.4 degrees or higher), cough, shortness of breath, unusual fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, recent loss of taste/smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.
- You have been in close contact with anyone with confirmed COVID-19.
- You had a positive COVID-19 test for active virus in the past 10 days.
- You are pending COVID-19 test results.
- A public health or medical professional told you to self-monitor, self-isolate or self-quarantine because of concerns about COVID-19 infection.

Please remember that it is your responsibility as an OOA patient to report any possible COVID-related symptoms or COVID exposure to our office prior to entering the facility by calling: **360-570-4860 Ext. 3142**
