

PREOPERATIVE PATIENT TO DO CHECKLIST FOR TOTAL HIP, TOTAL KNEE, PARTIAL KNEE JOINT REPLACEMENTS

- Review handout on dental protocols before and after your total joint replacement
- o Fill prescription medications before your surgery
 - ✓ All of these medications are to only be taken after your total joint replacement surgery
- o Notify your surgical team if you develop any medical concerns
 - ✓ Please also notify your surgical team if you develop any open sores, burns or lesions on your skin before surgery
- Schedule your preop physical therapy evaluation (prehab) AND postoperative physical therapy appointments
 - ✓ Prehab must be completed prior to surgery and will be completed by a physical therapist in order to help prepare you for surgery and for a safe home discharge
 - ✓ You will receive a call from our physical therapy office
 - ✓ Prehab must be completed at one of our Olympia Orthopaedic Associates physical therapy locations (West Olympia, East Olympia, or Hawks Prairie)
 - ✓ Post-op physical therapy may be done at a location of your choosing. We recommend you make your appointments at an office close to your home for your convenience
 - ✓ Your surgical team will provide a referral to you for prehab and postop physical therapy
 - ✓ Schedule these appointments as soon as possible, appointments fill up quickly and it is crucial to your recovery that you start physical therapy soon after your surgery
 - ✓ For total knee replacements you will need to schedule your first 6 weeks of postop physical therapy appointments, you will need to schedule 2 appointments each week
 - ✓ For total hip replacements you will need to schedule your first 2 weeks of postop physical therapy appointments, you will need to schedule 2 appointments each week
- Pick up medical assistive devices before surgery
 - ✓ A front wheeled walker is required
 - Please see the example to the right of a front wheeled walker, four wheeled walkers will not be allowed and are unsafe following a total joint replacement surgery.

Attend your required total joint class

✓ Designate a family member or close friend to attend with you that will be your "coach" after surgery

Medical Screening

- ✓ Preoperative appointment with your surgical team within 30 days of scheduled surgery
- ✓ Medical screenings may be required and if so, are <u>NOT</u> optional and are up to the discretion of your surgical team and the surgical facilities anesthesia group
- ✓ Medical screenings must be completed prior to your surgery

o Plan to discharge from the surgical facility once you are stable

- ✓ Our primary goal for all total joint replacements are for you to discharge home
- ✓ Upon discharge from your surgical facility you will need someone with you at home
- ✓ Following a total joint replacement discharging to a nursing facility or a rehabilitation center is rarely needed
